HANDGUN REFRESHER COURSE
TO PREPARE FOR TAKING THE
KENTUCKY CONCEALED CARRY CLASS**



Why should I be interested?

Enroll in our handgun refresher course before taking the Kentucky Concealed Carry class if you are concerned about qualifying on the range with your handgun. Kentucky-certified concealed carry instructors will assist you during this refresher course and you will practice shooting the **identical course of fire** you will have to pass to get your concealed carry permit. A great opportunity for those CCDW applicants who are new to handguns or don't shoot very often. These courses are scheduled one week before each CCDW class so you might want to enroll in the refresher course scheduled one week before your CCDW class to help ensure handgun proficiency.

What do I need to bring?

Your handgun, eye protection, ear protection, and at least 50 rounds of factory ammunition suitable for your handgun.

Where do I go?

The Club's Public Range. Follow the signs and drive past the Club's members-only ranges and proceed through the fence gate to the public range parking area.
