Minutes from July 21, 2008 Club Meeting

CALL TO ORDER: The monthly meeting of the Jackson Purchase Rifle and Pistol Club was called to order at 6:31 p.m. on July 21, 2008 at Paducah Shooter's Supply. President Mike Jones presiding.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES: The motion was made by Lee Miller that the minutes be approved as printed in the newsletter. The motion was seconded by Ricky Emerson. The motion was carried by the membership.

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL REPORTS: Phyllis McCutchen reporting: The beginning checkbook balance as of June 30, 2008 was \$9,674.39 with an ending balance of \$11,406.16 with an adjusted balance of \$10,853.16. Mike Jones reporting for Richard Roof on the investment account: The market was down over the past month so we lost about \$2,000.00; however with the market on the rise currently we are projected to recoup our loss over the next month or so. Ricky Emerson made the motion that the financial report be accepted as presented. The motion was seconded by Lee Miller. The motion was carried by the membership.

CONTINUING BUSINESS

Officer's Activity Reports
Mike Marshall reporting: The second 1 day PPC match went well. Not a big turn out with only 8 competitors shooting with 25 matches. He had a gross match income of \$99.00. He also reported that the brakes on the golf cart need to be fixed. That will be seen to ASAP for safety reasons. One of the

berms/dividing walls separating the public range from the rifle range is in need of repair. This is already being looked into. Lee Miller, Ricky Emerson, and he built and repaired target frames for the rifle and public ranges. He expressed the need for speed limit signs along the main access road and also road leading to the public range.

Ricky Emerson reporting: Good turn out for the Vintage match that was held on Saturday July 5th. He reported that the 1st relay was full but still had a decent turn out on the 2nd one. He built 2 test target frames out of PVC to be used by Vintage and High Power. If they prove to work as well as expected more will be built in the future. All of the signs advertising the ranges are complete. He's hoping to have them in place on Wed. July 23 (e.g., members only, no shooting beyond this point, bay designation with yardage on the public range.) He also expressed the need for new handicap parking signs to be placed on each of the ranges.

David Langston reporting on the Juniors: The last match was canceled due to the out of town shotgun match. He stated that the rifle program needs more young shooters.

The trap team took half of the trophy at the Louisville match. They brought home three 1st place trophies from Christian Co. Several others placed all the way down in all 3 age groups.

Larry Waggoner reporting on Cowboy Action: The Cowboy action was held on Saturday July 12th. He reported that

there were 12 shooters. BBQ was served for lunch.

Rebecca Cornwell reporting on Defensive Pistol for John Murr: There were 9 shooters for the first match that was held on Sunday July 6th. A good time seemed to be had by all that attended.

Rebecca also reported that the Office Depot rewards cards associated with the club account should arrive in about 4 to 6 weeks. In the mean time use the phone number to the stat house listed in the newsletter when making any purchases on the club account.

Darell Holcombe reporting: The Rimfire bench rest is having good turnouts. He is concerned about the heat and stated a fan or two would be nice. Would like to redo the lights and has already discussed this with Mike Jones.

Mike Jones reporting for Bob Longworth on Big Bore Silhouette: The Big Bore match that was held Sunday July 6th. There were 8 shooter with 10 rounds. All had a good time.

Mike Jones reporting: He will have the bowling pins and steel set up at the Charity Match to be held Aug. 9th and 10th. The plates will be rimfire only. His next regular match for the pins and plates will be held Saturday September 20th.
