Minutes from January 21, 2008 Club Meeting

Call to Order: The Jackson Purchase Rifle & Pistol Club met on January 21, 2008, at 6:35 p.m. at Paducah Shooter's Supply with President Mike Jones presiding.

Introduction of Guest: Shane Martin was introduced by Rebecca Cornwell.

Approval of Previous Meeting's Minutes: Minutes of the December 2007 meeting were introduced.

MOTION I: Glen Newtown motioned that the minutes be accepted. Rebecca Cornwell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Financial Report/Treasurer's Report: Phyllis McCutchen presented total for November and December 2007, with an adjusted checkbook balance of \$3,639.97 in November and \$2,666.31 in December. Also, the balance of the liquid CD was \$958.32 as of December 30, 2007.

Financial Report/Investment Manager's Report: Richard Roof stated that, although the market has taken a beating recently, the club's investment portfolio showed a loss of only

about \$200.00 prior to year's end, which put investments at about the same level as they were at the end of September 2007.

MOTION II: Lee Miller motioned that the financial reports be accepted as presented. The motion was seconded by Glen Newtown and carried by vote of the membership.

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

Officer Activity Reports: Mike Marshall reported that the public range will be reopening with abbreviated hours; otherwise, there is little activity due to the weather.

Target Orders: All discipline chairs are requested to get their target orders for the season turned in to Phyllis McCutchen as soon as possible.

NEW BUSINESS

Website: Shane Martin offered his services as website coordinator for the club in exchange for a reduced membership rate. This was acceptable to all members present.
