### CALL TO ORDER:

The monthly meeting of the Jackson Purchase Rifle & Pistol Club was called to order at 6:37 p.m. on May 19, 2008 at Paducah Shooters Supply, with President Mike Jones presiding.

### INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS:

Mr. Matt Wilson was introduced by President Mike Jones.

### APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS'S MINUTES:

A motion was made by Lee Miller to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as published in the Club Newsletter. The motion was seconded by Glenn Newton. The motion was carried by the membership.

### REVIEW OF FINANCIAL REPORTS:

Phyllis McCutchen reported the checkbook balance was \$4,792.58 at the beginning of April, and ended April with a balance of \$8,880.60. When the outstanding checks and deposits were accounted for, the adjusted balance for the month of April was \$5,393.47.

Richard Roof reported that the club investments are continuing to survive the current market slump fairly well. A motion was made by Glenn Newtown to accept the financial reports, seconded by Rick Emerson, and passed by the membership.

### CONTINUING BUSINESS:

Officers's Activity Reports.  
Mike Marshall reported that range cleanup day was very productive. Even though only fifteen people came out to help, the amount of work completed

was impressive. Numerous trees and limbs that were damaged or downed by the ice storms this past winter were cut up and hauled away. Damage to the pistol shed was repaired, the rifle shed was cleaned up, a large amount of broken target frames and other trash was removed from the ranges, and power was run to the 50 yard line on the rifle range for Bench Rest Rifle competitions.

Ricky Emerson reported that he had a good turnout for the May 3<sup>rd</sup> Vintage Match.

David Langston and Matt Wilson reported on the 4-H Competitions held Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup>. There were twelve rifle, nineteen pistol and forty shotgun competitors for the day. The weather could not have been better, the turnout was good, and the next match date is Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. David Langston and Matt Wilson discussed the 4-H match receipts for the shotgun, pistol, and rifle matches from the last weekend.

Lee Miller reported the Cowboy Action match held on May 10<sup>th</sup> had nineteen competitors, from Kentucky, Illinois, and Indiana. The Indiana shooters liked the Praying Mantis target bases. Lee Miller and Ricky Emerson are going to build two more target bases.

Darell Holcombe stated that the Bench Rest Rifle Matches for May 6<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> had twelve shooters each. The next Bench Rifle Match will be May 20<sup>th</sup>.

Mike Jones reported he cancelled the

Bowling Pins & Steel Plate Match back in March due to the weather.

Richard Roof reported that the next PPC match is scheduled for the weekend of May 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>.

George Reynolds reported that the last Hi-Power Rifle Match had fifteen shooters spread over two relays. The Match winner was Jim Wolfgang from Tennessee. The next Hi-Power Rifle Match is scheduled for June 14<sup>th</sup>.

25<sup>th</sup> Club Anniversary.  
Plans for the 25<sup>th</sup> Club Anniversary were discussed. Each of the shooting disciplines supported by the Club will have a demonstration set up on the ranges from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Most will be set up so the Club members can try shooting in the different disciplines available at the club ranges.

Lynn McCutchen reported that the Civic Center has been reserved for the Friends of NRA Banquet on August 28<sup>th</sup>. Tickets will be ordered by the next Club meeting. IDPA Club of West Kentucky  
John C. Muir stated that the IDPA club would follow the same precedent set by the other disciplines and organizations using club property, by giving the Club 50% of the match fees, and using the other 50% of operating expenses, awards, and other expenses. John and his wife Terry have submitted applications to join the Club. Lee Miller mad a motion for the Jackson Purchase Rifle & Pistol Club to host the IDPA club events. Glen Newtown seconded the motion, which was carried by the membership.
